Congratulations to Valerie Korman for an exceptional performance at the National Senior Games which took place in Des Moines, Iowa from July 25–28, 2025.

Val is a member of the Willow Valley Swim team and represented Pennsylvania in the biennial competition. She qualified for four races by earning two gold and two silver medals in her swimming events at the state level. This is the second time Val has qualified for the National Senior Games.

Val participated in the 50 meter freestyle, 100 meter freestyle, 100 meter breaststroke, and 200 meter breaststroke events and finished in the top 20 in her age group in every event. She finished 6<sup>th</sup> in the 200 meter breaststroke and 12<sup>th</sup> in the 100 meter breaststroke. Valerie also set new personal best times in two of her events.
